





be Youth Climate Negotiation Simulation

The **Youth Climate Negotiation Simulation** is a group role playing simulation of the international climate change negotiations. This exercise provides **30 young participants** the chance to explore the risks of climate change and the challenges of negotiating international agreements to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. In a live, face-to-face setting, participants play negotiators representing countries and regional blocs that work to create an agreement that limits climate change by reducing GHG emissions. Proposals are tested using a climate policy simulation model that provides participants science-based feedback on the implications of their proposals for atmospheric carbon dioxide concentrations, global mean surface temperature, sea level rise, and other impacts.

The simulation aims to provide participants with the following:

### 1. Insights and understanding

Offer an opportunity for participants to gain insights into the carbon and climate system, as well as the social and international geopolitical dynamics of the climate challenge.

### 2. Learning and Leadership

Provide a non-dogmatic experience for participants to think and explore, for themselves, about their possible role in addressing climate change and experiment in a role-playing environment on how to advocate for positive action.

### 3. Diffusion

Give participants an opportunity to take what they have learned and translate it into real-world action.




# POLICY & LEADERSHIP | 17 JAN ACCELERATING YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN CLIMATE ACTION AND ENERGY TRANSITION LEADING UP TO COP28

Today, there are **1.8 billion young people in the world**, aged between 10 and 24. This number is set to reach two billion, by 2050 (United Nations Development Program, 2016). It is estimated that a child born in 2021 will live through seven times as many heatwaves, and nearly three times as many droughts, as someone born in 1960. Yet the effects will not be felt equally around the world. **Young people in the developing world will bear the brunt of climate change**, according to the UNDP.

Yet around the world, **youths are leading positive change too.** They are demanding to be heard in decision-making spaces. They are making sure they are included in the design and implementation of climate action, at all levels.

Whether through education, science, or technology, young people are scaling up their efforts and using their voices, skills, and networks **to accelerate climate action**. Tackling the climate crisis requires ambition, action, and inclusivity. This can only be achieved if stakeholders recognize the valuable ideas and expertise that young people bring to the table.




# **INNOVATION & MEGATRENDS | 17 JAN DIGITIZATION TO NETZER02050:** THE NEW CLIMATE FRONTIER

Climate change has created fresh uncertainties about the future. This makes it even more important that young people's voices are heard. In addition, young people often drive entrepreneurship and innovation, and the youth of today will play a pivotal role in the green transition.




# YOUTH RESILIENCE, CAPACITY BUILDING & SKILLS | 18 JAN STRENGTHENING CAPACITY BUILDING AND SKILLS FOR A CLIMATE-RESILIENT YOUTH

Where will new jobs be created? One possible source is the expanding green economy. There could be **24 million jobs in the green economy by 2030**, according to the International Labor Organization.

Simultaneously, **digital innovation** is empowering industries to move towards a just energy transition, where Net Zero by 2050 is achieved. Therefore, young people who are planning their careers need to focus on **four critical areas**: gaining the most relevant educational background, developing soft skills, acquiring a professional network, and continuously learning and adapting.

The Forum will discuss **factors driving job market changes over the next decade.** It will also address questions such as: Which skills do young people need for **future climate change careers**? How can young people build their **green skills capacity**? What skills are needed to enable a just **green energy transition**? What jobs and sectors are likely to become the most sought-after to **achieve Net-Zero by 2050**?

Other topics of discussion include global south youth resilience dialogue, future-proofing skills for climate jobs and entrepreneurship, and climate change education for mitigation and adaptation.
