Saudi Arabia announced plans for 10GW of renewable energy by 2023, with 3.45GW of capacity commissioned by 2020.

The World Future Energy Summit (WFES), saw strong interest in Saudi business opportunities when the event opened as part of Abu Dhabi Sustainability Week on January 16, 2017.

While focusing on investment opportunities in Saudi Arabia. Over 78 meetings were arranged between Saudi delegations and project developers and investors. Saudi business delegations were given guided tours through the exhibitions to facilitate the sourcing of technologies and solutions.
